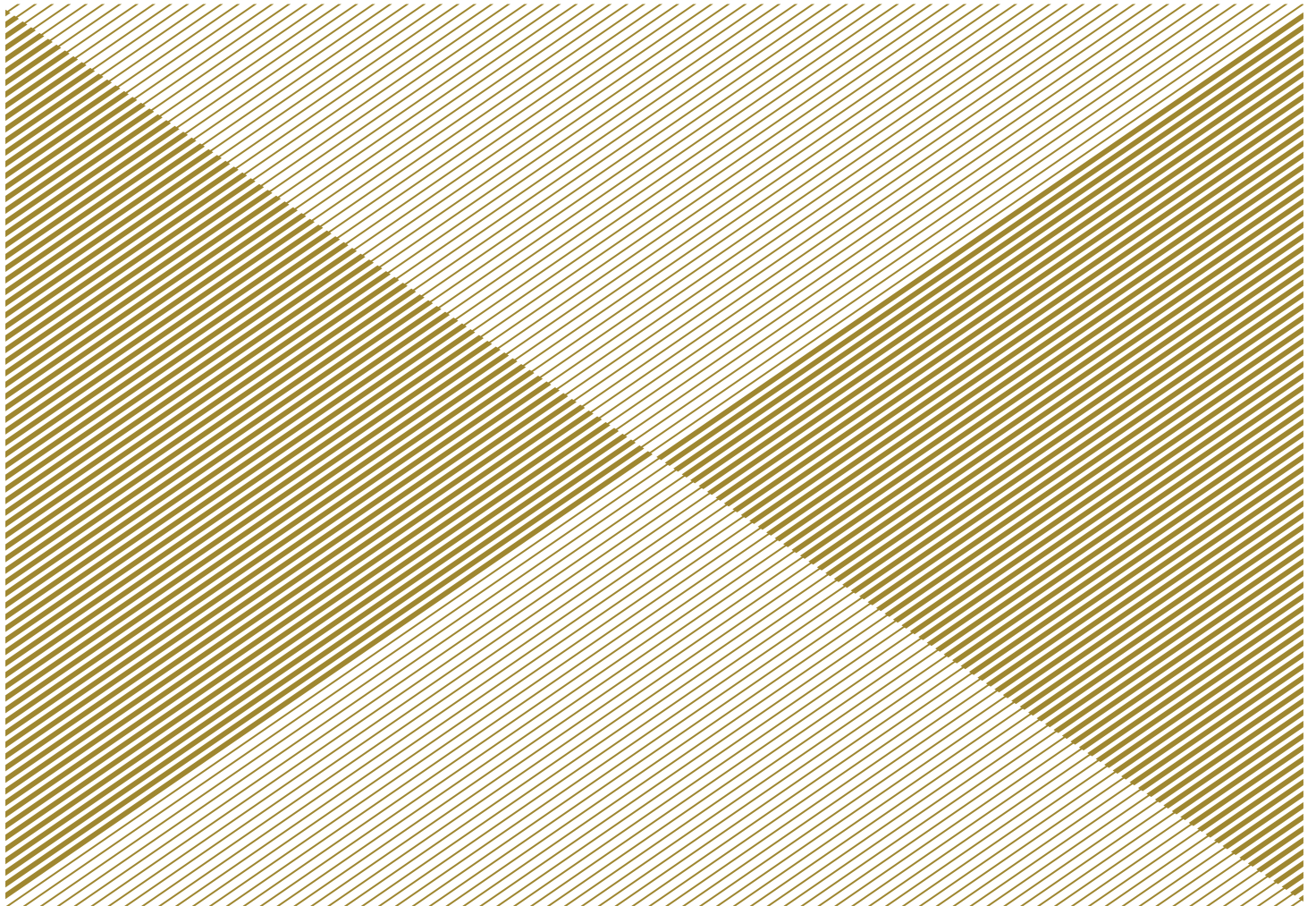

World Economic Forum Japan and the Fourth Industrial Revolution System Initiatives Workshop

Tokyo, Japan 10-11 October 2017



Background and Objectives

As we enter an era of disruptive change, advances in technology will fundamentally alter the way we live, work and relate to one another. As Japan seeks to embrace the digital transformation that is driving the Fourth Industrial Revolution and develop beyond connected industry into a super smart society, the need for collaboration among the public sector, private sector and civil society has never been more critical.

At this workshop, business leaders, policy-makers and experts will explore the transformation under way to grasp its systemic impact on value creation.

Focusing on digital society and economy, mobility, health, and production systems, the workshop will seek to accelerate the deployment of human-centred technologies and policy-oriented innovations through the Forum's platform to enable a smart and inclusive Japan.

The meeting will open on the evening of 10 October with a community dinner at the Roppongi Hills Club.

The following day, 11 October, will consist of both interactive working sessions and high-level panels. The themes of the discussions will be anchored to the Forum System Initiatives. Morning sessions will focus on the digital economy and society and how the internet of things, artificial intelligence and cybersecurity issues are affecting Japan. In the afternoon, participants will explore the future of production, global health and autonomous vehicles.
